

TOWN OF ASHFORD
TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

1989 – 1

The Town Board of the Town of Ashford, Cattaraugus County, State of New York, does hereby enact the following Ordinance:

SECTION 1. Prohibition of Parking in Designated Locations.

The parking or standing of vehicles in any of the following locations is hereby prohibited:

- A. On the south side of school street, in the hamlet of West Valley, between Route 240 and the westerly property line of West Valley Central School as it intersects School Street.

SECTION 2. Parallel Parking.

- A. No vehicle shall be parked on Route 240 (Main Street), west side, between Dole Avenue and White Streets, in the hamlet of West Valley, other than parallel with the edge of the highway, headed in the direction of traffic, and where there is a curb, the front and rear wheels shall not be more than six inches from the curb.

SECTION 3. Penalty for Violation.

Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 or 2 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of any offense against such Ordinance and any person violating the provisions of section 1 or 2 of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction , shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$100.00.

- A. For the purpose of conferring jurisdiction upon Courts and judicial officers generally, a violation of section 1 or 2 shall be deemed a misdemeanor and for the purpose only all provisions of law relating to misdemeanors shall apply to such violations.

SECTION 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
