

**Ordinance Prohibiting Parking  
of Vehicles on Town and County Roads**

**From November 1, to April 1**

**adopted 2-9-1977**

Pursuant to section 130 of the Town Law of the State of New York and section 1670 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, the Town Board of the Town of Ashford, Cattaraugus County, New York does ordain and enact as follows:

**Section 1. Purpose** – The purpose of this ordinance is to facilitate snow removal on Town or County highways during winter months for the general good, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town of Ashford and the public in general.

**Section 2. Definitions** – (a) The term “person” as used in this ordinance shall mean every natural person, firm, co partnership, association, or corporation; (b) the term “vehicle” as used in this ordinance shall mean every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks; (c) the term “park” or “parking” as used in this ordinance shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.

**Section 3. Prohibition** – Upon any Town or County highway within the Town of Ashford, no person shall park a vehicle, whether attended or unattended, within the Town or County highway right of way during the months of November, December, January, February, and March, except when a vehicle is disabled and it is impossible to avoid parking such disabled vehicle in such location.

**Section 4. Penalty** – Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50.00 for each violation.

**Section 5. Effective Date** – This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
